The Installing Officer addressed the Companions and directed the Grand Recorder to call the roll of Consistories in the Province.

V.Dist.Comp. Julian James Greenwall was obligated, invested, and installed as the Provincial Grand Summus of London, and was proclaimed and saluted under the direction of the Grand Director of Ceremonies.
