## **Preparation Ceremony for the Installation of President**


On Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> October 2021 at the South West Surrey Masonic Centre, Guildford, an Emergency Meeting of the Provincial Grand Senatus of Surrey was held to conduct the Preparation Ceremony for the office of President for four Companions of the Third Grade. The Ceremony was conducted by our Provincial Grand Summus, assisted by his Provincial Officers.



Provincial Grand Senatus was opened in the First Grade of the Order by the Provincial Grand Summus, who welcomed everyone to Guildford and thanked them for attending to support the Province.

The Consistory was then adjourned in the First Grade and the Provincial Grand Summus gave a short preamble as to why an Emergency meeting and its purpose, and briefly welcomed the guests

The Provincial Grand Summus then closed Provincial Grand Senatus in due form.


After a short break for tea a
